The CCD committee decided to make a change this year and keep the Halloween party in-house, thereby having no need for FLC involvement.

**-POINSETTIA PROGRAM:** Jan will contact Paula Hilchy regarding having the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade CCD students write Christmas greeting cards to be included with the poinsettias.
