

The St. John Paul Property Meeting of June 26, 2018 was held at the Charity Center. Members present were: Dick Wisniowski, Ron Burdick, John Bordeau, Allen Mendel, Neil Kupiec, Fred Pietras, Tom Douglas, Gary Bellows and Larry Clairmont.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

The Property Committee's Meeting order of business:

Notre Dame Steeple: No action. The committee is waiting for the diocesan engineer's reports and drawings for the installation of the metal plates for column 1 and the support rods for the trusses. Once the committee has the drawings/procedures we will request a quote to have the project completed before year end.

St. Stanislaus Steeples: No action. The Diocesan's Meeting was held on Monday July 2 at which time, their committee was to discuss the steeple problem and provide us with recommendations on how we should proceed with an assessment of the problem. The parish has not received any communication and therefore we are waiting for the Diocese to respond.

Solar Project: Gary reported to the committee that the solar panel project is presently at a standstill. He stated that the Solar Company has completed the preliminary work required. Before proceeding into the more detail aspects of the project, they are waiting to sign a contract to start the second phase of the project. When asked, Gary reported that the Solar Company was interested in the Polanka grounds (they would demolish the pavilion/building) and the north/east corner of the cemetery (which would be out of site from the cemetery).

Notre Dame Rectory Chimneys: Larry reported that the contractor has scheduled the first week of September to repair the chimneys.

Notre Dame Church Roof: We continue to wait for Woolliver Roofing to repair the small area on the east side of the church where two slates are missing and the west side where the lower roof leaks only when there is a heavy downpour.

St. Stan Rectory Trim Painting: The committee is waiting for the jail to identify a period of time when the inmates will have time to help with this project.

Polanka Grounds: In the past several weeks the parish has continued to receive complaints from a person living on Mill Street. The complaints pertain to the garden area at the south end of the grounds. In response to the complaints, Allen reported to the committee that the old basketball hoops have been removed, the pile of wood chip is gone and the area has been cleaned up. The committee will wait to see if the neighbor's attitude changes.

Property Fiscal Budget 2019: Tom reviewed with the committee his recommendations for the Property Committee's 2019 budget followed by a list of eight projects the committee has selected to undertake this fiscal year. A motion was made by Allen and a second by Neil to accept the recommendations and project presented. The Committee unanimously accepted.
