

ST. John Paul Buildings & Grounds Committee

The St. John Paul Buildings & Grounds Meeting of July 25, 2019 was held at the Charity Center. Members present were: Allen Mendel, Ron Burdick, and Larry Clairmont .

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M.

The Property Committee's order of business:

Notre Dame Church Roof: There was no leak during any days of rain in July on the lower west side roof of the Church. In the past eight months the leak only occurred once in June and there was only a small amount of water found on the pew after that downpour.

ND Classroom: Wall & Wilk completed repairing the roof over the classroom that had the leaks and installed new flashing. After two days of rain (July 22 & 23) there were no leaks. This project is completed.

St. Stanislaus Steeples: The Buildings & Grounds Committee on July 1 submitted their "Request for Proposals" (RFP) to the diocesan's Buildings & Grounds Office for the structural engineer and architectural evaluation. Before taking any action Russ Sprague needs to determine if the Bishop's approval is needed for this phase of the project.

Kolbe Hall: Kolbe Hall entrance at the bottom of the stairs had more water entering through the foundation. The Committee is considering removing the earth along the foundation and sealing the exterior wall.

St Stanislaus Choir: The intermittent leak in the choir on the east side continues to be monitored.

St. Stanislaus Rectory Gutters: Superior Seamless Gutters will be installed on August 6th. They will install 196 feet of gutters on the upper roof and front porch with four 25 feet down spouts.

St Stan's Church Chandeliers: The three chandeliers cleaning had been completed. In the base of the large chandelier 61 led bulbs were installed and in each small chandelier 6 led bubs were installed replacing all the old bulbs.

Polanka Grounds: The Larabee Company has completed the cleanup of the south end, removing all the weeds, small trees, vines and trash. The ruts near the pavilion were filled using dirt from the cemetery.

There is not SPJ Buildings & Grounds Meeting scheduled for August.
